Parent Handbook

At A Godly Seed Early Learning Centers Summer Camp, we have a great summer planned for your child. Safety, enrichment, and fun are our top priorities. We also include a time each day for academic review! Stem, art, and photography are just a few of the great experiences that your child will have this summer while making new friends. Exciting field trips are the highlight of each week.

Fees

To have a safe, productive summer season, it is very important that we plan ahead. All campers must be completely registered for desired camp session by the Friday before the session begins. Complete registration means all required paperwork has been submitted and all fees have been paid.

All campers must pay a one-time Registration Fee of \$100 and the Weekly Tuition of \$175. Part-time tuition (2 days or less) is \$70/per day. As a courtesy and convenience to our working parents, we offer before and aftercare. Before and/or Aftercare for children arriving before 9am and/or departing after 3pm is a flat fee of \$25 per week.

The Sibling Discount consists full price Weekly Tuition for the 1st child and \$10 off the tuition for for the 2nd, 3rd and 4th child.

Weekly fees must be paid in advance. schedule of payment due dates for tuition is as follows.....

- For Week 1: June 27th - July 1st - tuition must be paid no later than Friday, June 24th
- For Week 2: July 4th- July 8th (*closed 7/4*) - tuition must be paid no later than Friday, July 1st
- For Week 3: July 11th - July 15th - tuition must be paid no later than Friday, July 8rd
- For Week 4: July 18th - July 22nd - tuition must be paid no later than Friday, June 15th
- For Week 5: July 25th - July 29th tuition must be paid no later than Friday, July 22th
- For Week 6: Aug 1st - August 5th - tuition must be paid no later than Friday, July 29th
- For Week 7: Aug 8th - August 12th - tuition must be paid no later than Friday, Aug 5th
- For Week 8: August 15th - August 19th - tuition must be paid no later than Friday, Aug 12th
- For Week 9: Aug 22nd - August 26th - tuition must be paid no later than Friday, J Aug 19th
- For Week 10: Aug 29th - September 2nd - tuition must be paid no later than Friday, J Aug 26th

The roster for each session will be posted the Wednesday afternoon before. If your child's name is not listed, he/she has not completed registration for the upcoming week.

Camp Polices

- For safety and protection of camper's outsiders will not be allowed in the building during camp.
- Parents or a designated adult must sign campers in and out each day.
- Each camper's file will contain persons approved to pick up campers. Children will not be released to anyone that is not on the list. Any deviation from that rule requires parent consent.
- Camper should dress appropriately to participate in camp activities.
- Make sure camp staff is aware of any medicine your child must take during the day.
- If your child becomes ill or injured, you will be contacted immediately; make sure the number you have on file is correct, direct phone line to you.
- Persistent discipline problems will warrant immediate face-to-face parent conference. We cannot allow any campers right to benefit from our program to be compromised by inappropriate behavior from any other camper.
- All camp participants must be registered.

Meals

Campers will need to bring lunch and two snacks with them each day.

A Godly Seed Early Learning Centers Summer Camp will be offering a cold breakfast to campers who arrive before 7:30am.

Refrigeration is not provided; therefore, please keep in mind that the lunch should be packed in a manner so that it remains fresh and safe to eat throughout the day.

Microwave is provided.

Campers are advised to bring ice water.

Lost & Found

PLEASE LABEL ALL OF YOUR CHILDREN'S BELONGINGS.

There will be a basket designated for the Lost and Found. All items clearly marked with the camper's name will be returned to the owner. Unlabeled belongings will be thrown away if not claimed

What To Wear to Camp

A T-shirt, shorts, and rubber-soled shoes are appropriate camp wear. Failure to dress appropriately will exclude your child from some of the activities.

All shorts must be of appropriate length, and pants should be worn on the waistline. All shirts must have a neckline and sleeves and should cover stomachs (no midriffs or cut offs).

Injury and Illness

If a camper is injured or becomes ill during camp hours, we will care for him/her. You will be our first contact in case of illness or injury if the situation warrants, or if the camper needs to be taken home. If an emergency exists for an ill or injured child, 911 will be called, and every effort will be made to contact parents or guardians. A staff member will accompany any child transported to the hospital and will remain until the parent arrives. Workers are not allowed to sign anything to facilitate treatment.

Please note: It is imperative that we have all necessary information on file.

Without proper telephone numbers and contact persons, needed treatment could be delayed or denied. Parents will be contacted to come and take campers home for the following reasons:

- Covid symptoms
- Nausea/diarrhea/vomiting
- Conjunctivitis (Pink Eye)
- High Fever
- Chicken Pox
- Pediculosis (Head Lice)
- Earache
- Strep Throat
- Ringworms
- Or any injury or illness that requires a physician's care

What to Bring to Camp

A Godly Seed Summer Camp Staff is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Please use discretion when preparing your child for camp activities. Participants are allowed the following items at A Godly Summer Early Learning Summer Camp (please label all personal items):

Field Trips:

It is important that our participants get out to explore and enjoy new faces and places. Therefore, our schedule includes several field trips. Field trips require a fee to participate you will be notified in advance of those trips.

If a child is attending camp on the day of the field trip, he/she must attend the field trip.

No day of registrations will be taken on field trip days.
